July 3, 2013

1. Meeting called to order at 6:03 PM
2. There were no public comments
3. A motion to approve the minutes from the June 5 meeting was made by Tom Hill, seconded by Richard Peckham. Motion passed.
4. Mail consisted of information from UNH about their Covert Project Workshop in September and The Moose Mountain Regional Greenway Gazette.
5. Old Business: Tom Hill reported on the TRAC program and it was noted that more volunteers were needed. Tom Giguere reported that a Land Conservation Workshop will be held in New Durham on July 25th. Jennifer McKown will lead the hike to Copple Crown on August 10th Old Home Day. Richard Peckham will contact MMRG to see if they have information to pass out on Old Home Day.
6. New Business: Tom Giguere furnished an update on the Acton Wakefield Watershed Alliance. SPNHF announced a campaign to try and protect Mount Major hiking trails, some of which now cross private land. Northern Pass has changed some of the routing for the proposed lines. MMRG 11th Annual Woods, Water, and Wildlife Festival will be August 10th. Unfortunately, that is the same as Brookfield's Old Home Day.
7. Selectman William Nelson reported on the ongoing meetings in regard to The Churchill School House. A decision on the project is expected by mid-August.
8. Selectman Richard Zacher reported that the Planning Board was continuing to work on the Capital Improvement Plan.
