Minutes of May 1, 2013 Meeting

1. Meeting called to order at 6:02 PM
2. There were no public comments
3. Minutes from the April 3, 2013 were reviewed. Motion to accept by Tom Giguere and seconded by Tom Hill. Motion passed.
4. There was no new mail.
5. Appointments and reappointments to the commission were approved by the selectman. Those persons must be sworn in by the town clerk. A letter to Dulcie Lavender thanking her for her many years of service on the commission (written by R. Peckham) has been delivered. Town clean-up day was a success. All town roads were done except Pike Brook and Richard Peckham kindly volunteered to do that road. The selectmen have graciously donated the approximately \$85 donated at the Selectman's Breakfast to the Conservation Fund.

MMRG Branch River Paddle on May 25<sup>th</sup> was announced as well as a Water Quality Cruise on Winnepesaukee on June 9<sup>th</sup> and a Land Conservation Workshop at New Durham on July 25<sup>th</sup>. Old Home Day on August 8<sup>th</sup> will feature a breakfast put on by the Historical Commission and a hike up Copple Crown led by Richard Peckham.
7. Selectman Bill Nelson reported that a survey is coming up concerning the needed repairs to the School House.
8. The planning board is holding a hearing on May 13<sup>th</sup> regarding Frisbee Golf at Mouse Mountain.
9. A motion was made by Richard Peckham to obtain two new Conservation Commission handbooks to replace the older ones. The motion was seconded by John Nelson and passed by voice vote.
10. The date for the next meeting is June 5, 2013.
