### Minutes of May 4, 2016 Meeting

1. Meeting called to order at 6:05 P.M.
2. No public comments.
3. Minutes of April 6, 2016 meeting reviewed. Dick Peckham made a motion to approve. Terry Jones seconded. Motion was passed.
4. Mail:
  - A. Received monthly statement from Meredith Village Savings. Deposit of \$500.00 per Town Meeting and interest paid \$ .10. New balance \$4089.16.
  - B. Received copy of MMRG Gazette.
  - C. Received flyer from NH Lakes advising of Lakes Congress meeting in Meredith on June 2 and June 3, 2016.
  - D. Received notice from State of NH Environmental Services concerning approval of permit on property at Kingswood Lake.
  - E. Received email concerning expedited land application for Huber's on Kingswood Lake for planting of native plants.
  - F. Also received letter from State of NH approving the above expedited land application.
5. Old Business:
  - A. The following CC members' reappointment was approved at the Selectmen's Meeting on April 12, 2016: Tom Hill, Jean Jones, and George Yeager-Alternate.
  - B. MMRG bill for 2016 dues has been forwarded to town treasurer.
  - C. The town cleanup this year only had 11 people sign up to clean roads. The Commission would like to thank all who participated. Cheryl White and Sara Charles cleaned quite a bit.

- D. Dick Peckham brought plans for building birdhouses to be used next Spring in the Town Forest. A copy of the plans will be on the CC web page for anyone who would like to help build birdhouses.
- E. Tom Hill discussed the town forest management funding from the CC account. Tom found that is OK to use CC funds for forest. Also discussed the stewardship of the town forest and if the CC should handle. Since land will not be purchased until October, 2016, this will be an ongoing discussion.

- A. Tom Hill advised that the Kinder Morgan pipeline project has been put on hold and may no longer exist.
- B. Tom Hill advised that the planned Bobcat season did not pass.
- C. The town received a copy of a check for \$630.00 from the Lakes Region Conservation Trust as a donation.
