

HERITAGE COMMISSION MEETING

Wednesday, 14 June 2017

Present: Marilou MacLean; Harriet Wilson; Brian Robischeau; Rich Zacher; and Fred Cann.
The meeting was held in the Town Office Building.

We were called to order at 7:05 pm by Marilou. As the minutes of the last meeting (October 2016) were approved by an email vote there were no minutes to approve.

Marilou reported that Patricia Golden and Steve Michalsky have resigned from the Commission. We need to find interested replacements in the community. Brian moved to renew Marilou's appointment as chair of the Commission; Harriet seconded the motion and it passed by a vote of 2 - 0 with one abstention (Marilou). Marilou reported that several desks, chairs, books, and other material from the Churchill School House have been sold. More books will be sold and more still will be sent to auction along with a wobbly bookcase. Proceeds from the sale of books and desk from the Churchill Schoolhouse in 2016 and 2017 are \$285.00; these proceeds are going to the Town General Fund. Two desks were donated to the Ossipee Historical Society auction and two of the hymnals were donated back to the Wakefield Congregational Church for its archives.

We discussed the disposition of the bricks from the School House chimney, and decided to dispose of them, keeping 4 or 5 labeled as to source.

The School House exhibit is now complete. Much of the work was done before Election Day in November 2016.

Harriet reported that the recreational trail from Wolfeboro to Sanbornville is in its final stages and should be completed this summer. Work is currently being done on the last section, approximately 1.7 miles, from Cotton Valley to Clark Road in Brookfield.

The Old Home Day dinner is scheduled for August 12. Rick Surette will be doing the cooking again and is hoping to provide a band since Lance MacLean and his band are not available this year. Things will be done much as last year - details will be arranged at the July meeting.

Heritage Commission meetings will revert to the second Wednesday of the month beginning with the July meeting. The next regularly scheduled meeting will be held on July 12, 2017 at 7:00 pm.

We adjourned at 7:30 pm.
