Brookfield Presents Tales from the Archives

Brookfield – Join us on Saturday, November 4, 2023, at 10 AM at the Brookfield Town House on Route 109. Craig Evans our Town Archivist will be giving us a glimpse into the ledgers and information in the Town Archives. Craig has created a PowerPoint program to show special photographs and some objects that are representative of the residents and history of Brookfield.

He will show us examples of early school registers and early 20th century photos of Mountain Lake Camp. We have in the archives 19th century photos of the Colman, Churchill and Hackett families. Craig will also show 19th century militia records. We have the Town record books from 1778 to current, many of which have been restored and conserved.

Another wonderful part of our collection are the town weights and measures which will be on display. Craig will also briefly discuss the importance of a town archive and our town's record retention in compliance with RSA 33-A. He will also take time to answer any questions from the public.

This is the final program in this series celebrating our beautiful Town House and what it stands for in our community. We have remembered this wonderful building's history, as well as the Churchill Schoolhouse which sits behind the Town House. We have had a couple of special coffee hours with special programs on local gardens and an ice cream social as well as our annual Town Barbque for the community.
